

California Western School of Law (“CWSL”) COVID-19 Protocols for Campus Community Exposure
Incidents and Positive Cases

The CWSL community has gone to extraordinary lengths to ensure that we minimize opportunities for the transmission of the COVID-19 virus; the rate of vaccination alone is incredible, with 99% of staff and faculty, and 94% of students having received a vaccine. While we are taking steps to limit exposure to COVID-19 on campus, should there be an exposure incident or positive case within our campus community, we have the following protocols in place:

- We are following public health guidance as we open our campus facilities and will continue to do so.
- A committee of school officials continues to meet regularly to discuss and respond to COVID-19 issues, including any CWSL positive cases and exposures.
- When we are notified by public health officials, an employee, or student of a positive case, we have established a system for notifying employees, and students with information about the occurrence as recommended by San Diego county
- We have established a relationship with health professionals who will advise us and recommend actions the law school may need to consider in response to CWSL exposure incidents and positive cases.
