Guiding Principles

- The health, well-being, and safety of our community are paramount.
- As state and county laws, public health orders, and guidance evolve, we may make adjustments. Continue to check with school officials and this policy for the latest information.

Required off-campus activity modifications

The following event modifications are in effect:

- Masking rules should follow the current CWSL policies regarding masking. The current policy at CWSL is that masks are not required on campus. However, students and volunteers at off campus sites that require masks must adhere to the masking guidelines of that site. CWSL masking requirements are subject to change depending on CDC guidance.
- Venues should follow state and local health guidelines in force on the date of the activity.
- Activity organizers should follow state and local health guidelines in force on the date of the activity, as well as all other CWSL policies, and recognize that CWSL has the right to modify or cancel an activity at any time.
- Contracts signed with venues should contain force majeure clauses that allow cancellation and refund or rescheduling if state and local health guidance dictates that the event cannot be held.

Clinic directors may use their discretion in requiring attendee lists at events.
